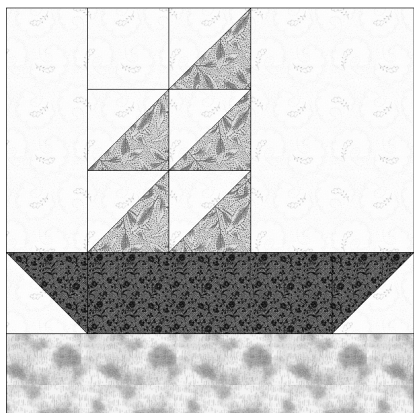


Sail Boats—The Perfect Summer Block



This cute little block, comprised completely of squares and half square triangles, is perfect for summer.

Our version is 10 inches, but it is easily adaptable to other sizes.

*Use your favorite half square triangle method to make the

following 2 1/2 inch half square triangles:

5 Light Blue/.Dark Blue squares

2 Red/Light Blue squares

You will also need the following:

2 1/2 x 6 1/2 Light Blue Rectangle

4 1/2 x 6 1/2 Light Blue Rectangle

2 1/2 inch Light Blue Square

2 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch Red

Rectangle

2 1/2 x 10 Dark Blue Rectangle

Assemble as pictured.

This little block makes a terrific baby quilt when 20 of them are stitched together with or without sashing.

Or make two of them and separate them with a quick appliquéd anchor block for a great little table runner with a nautical feel.

A set of them would look lovely as placemats.

If you decide to make this block, or if you have neat summer block ideas, be sure to drop Kate a note and let her know.

*1 Method: Place 3" square Light Blue and 3" square Dark blue right sides together.

Draw a line along the diagonal.

Stitch 1/4" seam on both sides of the line. Cut along the diagonal line.
